Reliance acsn intends to save water by 10% by taking the following actions:

- Petitioning the Landlord of Northburgh House to install a cistern volume reducer
- These small bags of water are inserted into toilet cisterns and save water with every flush (note: these should not be used with dual flush systems)
- For men's toilets, ask the landlord of Northburgh House to consider installing a flush control system – these are now fitted as standard in new commercial buildings. Approximate cost £150 per controller
- Stop dripping taps to reduce unnecessary water waste – this can be combatted by fitting a new washer as well as ensuring there are replacements available
- Make sure plugs are available for washing hands, dishes or food. If you need a certain depth of water to wash something small, but only have a very large sink, use a bowl
- Dish wash efficiently - Only use the dishwasher when you have a full load and use a setting appropriate to what is being washed – reducing temperature and time where possible
- Showers - consider switching to low flow, high velocity showers which use less water
- Where possible, introducing the use of self-closing tap fittings to reduce water waste created by taps being left turned on
- Where possible, introduce flow restrictors on taps to reduce unnecessarily high flow on taps.
